1st Annual Kids Rock Camp Scheduled for July

OKLAHOMA CITY, Okla. – The Bethel Foundation has announced the first annual Kid’s Rock Camp scheduled for the week of July 28th at Britton Christian Church’s gym. The camp will encompass music therapy combined with basic cooking techniques and life skills development activities to help the children of single parents understand the importance of chipping in to help mommy succeed.

Each day at the camp will be a new adventure for the children. Some of the activities planned are: Fire Prevention with the Oklahoma City Fire Department, Home Alone with the Oklahoma City Police Department, Special Story Time with the local library, Reptile Extravaganza by the Oklahoma City Zoo and Basic CPR and 1st Aid with the Red Cross. Along with the daily activities, the children will have hands on nutrition classes that will teach them basic cooking techniques to help their mothers. Each child will be sent home with a bag full of groceries each day with the ingredients to share their recipes with the rest of their family. At the end of camp, each child will receive a back pack full of school supplies.

“We’re excited about our first Kids Rock Camp,” Lynda Powell, Bethel Foundation Founder said. “Our goal is to offer a child-centered educational experience that promotes the nurturing of positive self-worth through the strengthening of innate gifts and talents. Priority is given to empowering children with skills to cope with life’s circumstances and to learn at the same time.”

Nancy Malone, Bethel Foundation Volunteer, added, “We’re providing this camp at no charge to children of single mothers in 3rd-5th grade. We have limited spaces available for the camp, but are still in need of campers. We want all of our spots to be reserved to ensure the success of the program.”

“Sponsors will be helping a charitable organization that provides opportunity for at-risk children to participate in a social learning environment where they can develop lifelong skills
