



Participation Requirements 2010

Thank you for your interest in becoming a part of Bethel Foundation's "**All American Idol**" competition. Below you will find the guidelines for auditioning.

- U.S. Citizen:
 - Contestants must be able to prove they are a U.S. Citizen of the United States.
- Age restrictions:
 - Contestants must be 16 years of age on or before August 20, 2010 and no more than 40 years of age on or before the same date.
 - Participants under the age of 18 must have permission from their parent or legal guardian to audition, and must be accompanied by one parent or guardian. If the parents or guardians are unable to attend, another adult may supervise, but a signed affidavit of permission must be included with registration forms.
 - The affidavit must include the parent/guardian name, date, and signature along with names and signatures of contestant and third party supervising participant.
- Photo ID:
 - All contestants 18 years of age or older will be required to present a photo ID in order to audition. Minor contestants without a state ID or driver's license may use a school ID and copy of birth certificate. Otherwise the parent, guardian, or third party supervisor must provide valid photo ID and birth certificate with parent's name and child's name listed.
- Prior participation;
 - Any individual who has previously been named Bethel's "All American Idol" and received first place prizes WILL NOT be eligible to participate in the competition again.

Bethel Foundation and the producers of **All American Idol** reserve the right to refuse an audition of any individual act for any reason at the sole discretion of the foundation.
